Patient Safety notification for contractors using EMIS PharmOutcomes IT system

NHS England has been made aware of a technical issue with service notifications (electronic post event messages) not being sent to some GP practices following clinical service consultations in community pharmacy for a range of services.

Most community pharmacy IT supplier service level agreements (SLAs) require notifications to be sent to the patient's registered general practice within 24-48 hours.

Ordinarily, notifications will be sent by secure email where a GP practice has a confirmed email address. However, in the absence of a valid email address for the practice, the pharmacist (or other pharmacy team member) must ensure the notification is sent via an atternative method e.g. via email or manually printed and delivered. This requirement is described within the relevant advanced service specification.

NHS England is now reviewing the issue and backlog of notifications, and will provide additional information to support pharmacies in managing any historic messages. We hope to share this next week. EMIS PharmOutcomes has also contacted system users directly through an in-system message.

Action for contractors

While this review is taking place, NHS England asks contractors to:

- From 24 June 2024 onwards, where there is no valid email address for a GP practice, please ensure any new notifications are sent by an alternative method to the GP practice and confirm this by clicking 'Sent Manually' within EMIS PharmOutcomes to avoid adding to a backlog of electronic notifications.
- Please await further guidance on managing historic unactioned messages. Please do not action any historic notifications at this stage.

The next meeting is scheduled for July 17, 2024, at 8 PM.


The agenda will include introducing a new inhaler pilot and prescription switching programme by LLR ICB and regional news updates.

LPT Generic prescribing of 12hour methylphenidate slow release tablets

We've coordinated with Leicestershire Partnership Trust (LPT) for months to help LLR community pharmacies get ADHD medicine stock.

Contractors have asked about prescribing these medicines generically due to supply issues with bio-equivalent 12-hour methylphenidate slow-release tablets. We've addressed these concerns with LPT and ICS. Thank you for your patience. Due to supply uncertainties, LPT will now prescribe these tablets generically, effective from 12th June **2024**. This short-term arrangement will be reviewed in a few months. Note: This applies only to 12-hour slow-release methylphenidate tablets. Medikinet XL, Equasym XL, Myterol XL, and Meflynate XL will still be brand prescribed. Scripts will include a note for guidance. Contact the prescriber if unsure.

Update to Annual Flu Letter on vaccine availability

The Department of Health and Social Care, NHS England and the UK Health Security Agency have issued a statement of amendment to the Annual Flu letter.

This has been issued, following the news from Sanofi that recombinant quadrivalent influenza vaccine (QIVr) will not be available for this year's flu vaccination programme.

The amendments to the Annual Flu letter include a new flu vaccine which can be used for the first time – high-dose quadrivalent influenza vaccine (QIV-HD) – which is only licensed for those aged 60 years and over.
