## Reminder: Pharmacy Profile Manager

The NHS website has a number of search tools that enable members of the public and healthcare professionals to search for services delivered by Community Pharmacies in their local area. These search functions use the Pharmacy NHS profiles to check what services each Pharmacy delivers.

Where a Pharmacy is registered for a service but does not have it selected on their Profile Manager, the Pharmacy will not appear in the search results. According to NHS Terms of Service, Pharmacy owners must verify and update their opening hours, contact details, facilities, and services information for each profile every financial quarter.

**You can attend if:**

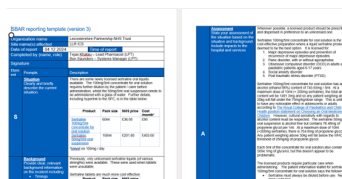
- Your cervical smear is overdue

## **GPhC Publishes Guidance to Strengthen Safeguards to Prevent Unsafe Supply of Medicines**

**The General Pharmaceutical Council has recently published updated guidance that all online Pharmacies are expected to follow, in response to concerns identified relating to unsafe prescribing and supply of medicines online.**

The updated guidance emphasises that for high-risk medicines, the prescriber cannot base prescribing decisions on the information provided in an online questionnaire alone. Instead, the prescriber has to independently verify the information the person provides, either through timely two-way communication with the person, accessing the person's clinical records, or contacting the person's GP, their regular prescriber, or a third-party provider.
